



Getting to the Brudenell Social Club

The Brudenell Social Club is a 15 minute walk from Hyde Park Corner, where many buses from the centre of Leeds stop. It is also on the 56 bus route. Full details can be found here: www.brudenellsocialclub.co.uk/contact/directions

Parking

There is a car park on site with level access to the building. The car park costs 50p per hour or £2.50 for all day. There is also free street parking in the surrounding area.

Arrival and Entry

Our event will have its own level access entrance through the fire escape on the right hand side as you are looking at the building. There will be an orange sign on the door saying Made with Music Mini-Gig. The whole building can be accessed by a wheelchair or pushchair and you are welcome to use the bar, games room or other social areas at any time.

Tickets

Please bring your e-ticket with you (on a phone or other electronic device is fine) as it will speed up the entry process. If you can't bring it or you forget, don't worry, we'll have your name on a list.

During the event

There will be three acts, each performing a twenty-five minute set. Timings will be confirmed and advertised clearly on the day. At the moment, we expect the following timings:

2pm	Doors open
2.45-3.10pm	Act 1
3.25-3.50pm	Act 2
4.05-4.30pm	Act 3
5pm	End

Noise Levels

The acts will be amplified to ensure everyone can hear over background noise, but all are used to playing acoustically and sound levels will be lower than a standard gig.

Made With Music

We are trying to arrange to have some ear defenders available to borrow, but we would recommend bringing your

own if your child would be more comfortable wearing them.

Lighting

Lighting levels will be higher than a standard gig. No strobe lighting or fast lighting changes will be used.

Support within the venue

We will have a number of volunteers wearing white Made with Music t-shirts around the venue if you need any help finding your way around or if you have any questions.

Seating

We will have cushions and mats available for sitting on the floor, but please bring your own if you would like to. There will also be chairs available for anyone who is unable to sit on the floor or who would prefer a chair. There is a wheelchair viewing area at the back of the room, but we anticipate that most of the audience will be seated so you will be able to see from anywhere in the room, whether in or out of a chair.

Toilet and Changing Facilities

There are toilet cubicles and an accessible toilet with a baby change unit inside the venue. Thanks to Scope Activities for All, we also have a mobile Changing Places unit available immediately outside the venue - it has an adult sized adjustable changing table and room for two carers.

Quiet Room

Due to space restrictions, we won't be able to provide a quiet room. There are other spaces in the venue away from the live stage, but not away from all people. There are also benches outside for fresh air.

Food and drink

There is a bar at the venue and pieminister pies are served (menu here: www.brudenellsocialclub.co.uk/pies) You are welcome to bring snacks for little ones or any food for medical or fussy eater needs (no massive picnics though please!)
