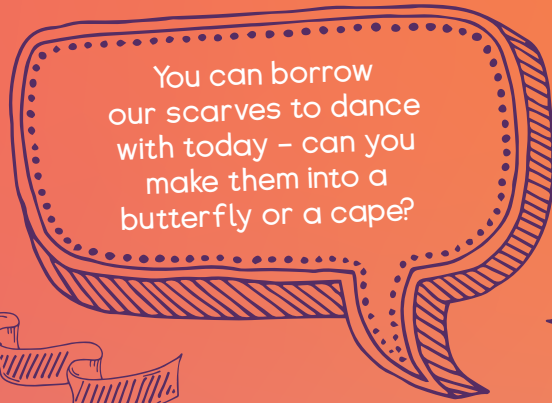
### Hum Gospel

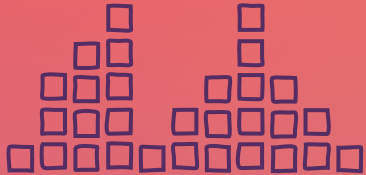
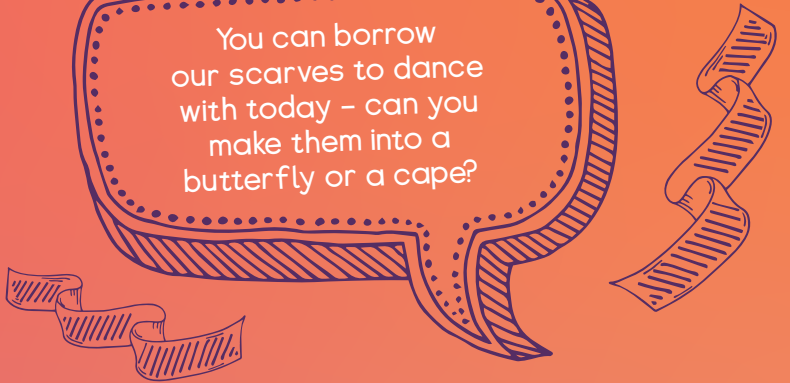

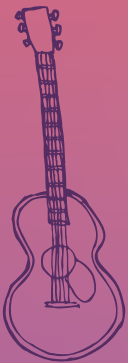
